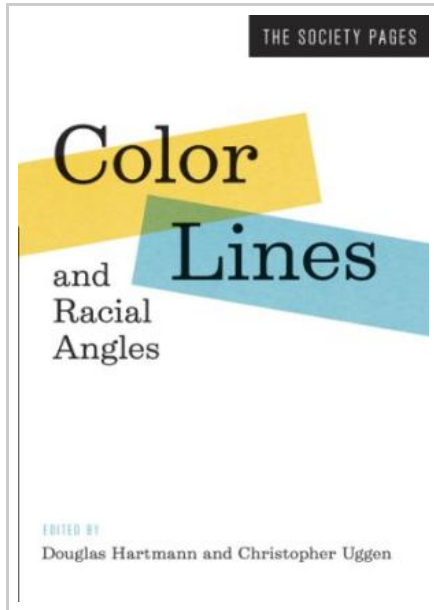




Color Lines and Racial Angles (Paperback)
