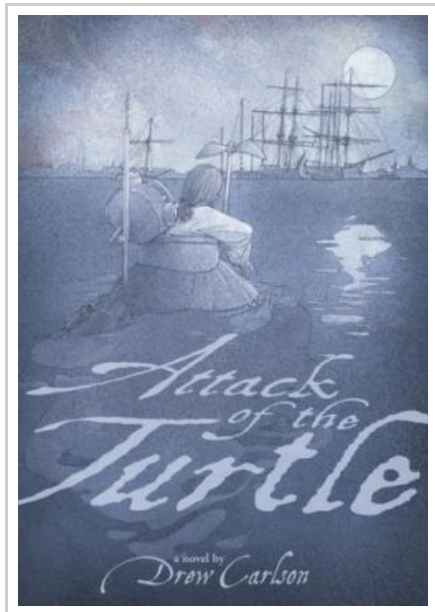




Attack of the Turtle (Paperback)
